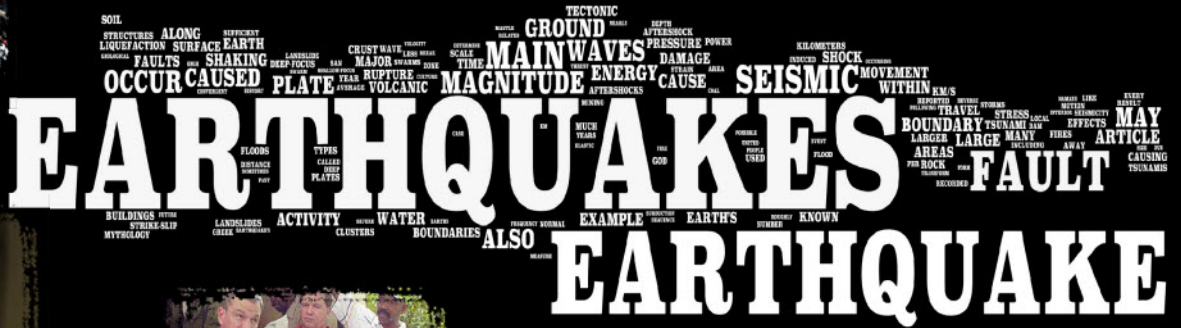
# Yéle Haiti Earthquake Fund

Beaverbrook STEP will be contributing emergency relief donations to the Yéle Haiti Earthquake Fund. Yéle Haiti, a nonprofit foundation, was begun in 2005 by Wyclef Jean, Grammy-Award winning musician, humanitarian and Goodwill Ambassador to Haiti. 100% of funds raised and donated to Yéle will go to the relief operation providing emergency assistance to Haiti.



From 4:30 PM to 7:30 PM on Thursday evening, January 21, 2010, Beaverbrook STEP will be holding a fundraiser for staff in order to raise money so Beaverbrook STEP can donate to Yéle Haiti. Beaverbrook STEP employees are urged to stop by or call in to contribute. Beaverbrook STEP will allow any donation to be made through a single payroll deduction or spread over a series of payroll deductions (no more than 4 payrolls.)
